6. **CORRESPONDENCE**

The Town Clerk reported on the following items of correspondence:

- a) **Burnley-Padiham Greenways Celebration Week Planning Event - 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2010 6.00pm at Padiham Green Primary School.** Everyone is invited to attend and Town Councillors were encouraged to contact Schools and Youth Groups to be represented. The Town Clerk has a copy of the Agenda and copies were circulated to all Town Councillors.Padiham.
- b) **Dog Fouling on the Greenway** – Roy Halliday from REMADE had emailed indicating that 5/6 bins are to be sited on the Greenway and the area designated during April. Members of the Gawthorpe PACT Meeting together with the Police and Dog Warden had recently walked the Greenway and whilst Fixed Penalty tickets could not be issued at the present time, some tickets were issued in Padiham.
- c) **Padiham Weir and Fish Pass** – Darren Wilson of the Environment Agency (Fisheries) had emailed. Plans are now in place for a fish migration route at the Weir and working is hoping to start in March lasting 3 months.
