1. Minutes

2. Matters arising and updated information

It was reported that the Traffic Regulation Order in respect of Burnley Road, Padiham had been approved at the meeting of Lancashire Locals held on 10th August 2009.

The Mayor and Councillor Jkinson had attended the meeting and made representations opposing the establishment of the Order, which would mean that local shopkeepers would lose their parking rights, however the Committee had approved the Order on safety grounds.

Councillors queried whether it was possible to appeal against the decision. Ruth Wynn indicated that she would establish whether an appeal was possible.

The Committee considered a planning application for display of an illuminated sign at 34 Burnley Road, Padiham.

The application related to the new signage which was required as the name of the Bradford and Bingley had changed to Santander. Councillors considered the proposed design of the signage.

4. Payment of accounts


The payment of an invoice of £141.58 to Ricoh was noted
