3. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST** – no declarations although Cllr. Tatchell was not present during the discussion of the Planning Applications
  
4. **MINUTES OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING** held on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2008 were **AGREED UNANIMOUSLY** and signed as a correct record.
  
5. **MATTERS ARISING AND UPDATED INFORMATION**
  - a) **BARGAIN BOOZE** – the Town Clerk reported that no contribution will be forthcoming from Alliance and Leicester in relation to the installation of additional CCTV. Funding in excess of £500.00 may be sought from the Town Council. It was **AGREED UNANIMOUSLY** that alternative funding sources be sought via Crime Safety at Burnley Borough Council. A further report will be available in due course.
  
  - b) **GROVE LANE – HUNTROYDE ESTATE** – the Town Clerk reported that no progress had been made with Ingham and Yorke. Lancashire County Council Highways had been contacted but the situation had not yet been addressed. It was suggested that the local press be approached with a view to writing an article. The situation will be monitored.
  
  - c) **BURNLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL DEVELOPMENT BRIEF** – the Town Clerk had made a request to the Borough Council for officers to attend to discuss with the Town Council the current and future plans for Padiham Town Centre and the Town Council Area. A suggested date is awaited.
  
  - d) **PLANNING APPEAL – WHALLEY ROAD, PADIHAM** – the Town Clerk has a copy of the Residents' response to the appeal.
  
  - e) **PLANNING APPLICATION - 23/25 SPENSER STREET PADIHAM** – the Town Clerk reported that the Application had been refused by the Borough Council and an Appeal was being lodged.


